**Scholarship Program**

NAPM-KC has established a scholarship program to assist members and their immediate families, who plan to continue education in college advanced degrees, and C.P.M. and CPSM. Scholarships are offered each year.

The Education Committee of NAPM-KC will administer this scholarship program. Awards are granted without regard to race, color, creed, religion, gender, sexual orientation, veteran status, disability, or national origin. The recipient must provide proof of United States Citizenship.

**Eligibility**

Applicants to the NAPM-KC Scholarship Program must be one of the following:

1. Active members in good standing with the local NAPM-KC, immediate family member, student member, and life time member.
2. NAPM-KC family member who are high school seniors or high school graduates who plan to enroll or students who are already enrolled in a full-time business program of study at an accredited two or four-year college or university.
3. NAPM-KC members in good standing who are pursuing advanced certification, i.e., C.P.M. and/or CPSM.

\* Full-time study is defined as full-time enrollment for the entire upcoming academic year.

**Awards**

The Scholarship Committee will award up to \$2,000 per year to eligible candidate(s). Award(s) are not renewable, but members and students may reapply to the program each year that they meet eligibility requirement. Scholarship award(s) less than \$500.00 are mailed to each successful recipient's home address. Scholarship award(s) greater than \$500.00 are mailed to the Institution that the recipients is enrolled at the start of the next semester or term. Application does not guarantee approval.

**Application**

September 11, 2007

Interested members or students should complete the application, which follows these guidelines, and mail it along with a current, complete official transcript of grades to the Director of Education, postmarked designated deadline. On-line transcripts and grade reports are not acceptable. Applicants will receive email acknowledgement of receipt of their application. If an email acknowledgement is not received within three (3) weeks, applicants may call or email the Director of Education to verify that the application has been received.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated based on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by the Education Committee.

Application does not guarantee approval.

### **Selection of Recipients**

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, unusual personal or family circumstances, and outside references.

Recipients will be notified timely as to their status for a scholarship from the Director of Education. Awards will be announced in May of each year. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients. Students may reapply to the program each year they meet the eligibility requirements.

### **Obligations**

Recipients have no obligation to NAPM-KC except that they are required to supply NAPM-KC with complete transcripts when requested, and notify NAPM-KC of any changes of address, school enrollment, or other relevant information.

### **Revisions**

NAPM-KC reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time, including the termination of the program.
